How to Apply to be a CUUPS Chapter

1. Verify you have three members of the congregation who are also members of CUUPS
2. Fill out the chapter application by printing it or filling in the pdf form provided on your computer.
3. Go to your congregation's governing body for approvals and develop a covenant with them
4. Send the application, covenant, dues and board minutes (or letter from the minister) to membership@cuups.org or the organization's address on the application

Our Executive Director will review the application, verify your memberships and submit the chapter to the board for approval at the next meeting. Your chapter will be listed on our website.

Policies on Local CUUPS Chapters

To be recognized as a CUUPS chapter, a group must:

1. Be in sympathy with the CUUPS mission and the UUA Principles and Purposes.
2. Obtain authorization from the minister and/or board of the hosting congregation to form a CUUPS chapter and operate as part of the congregation.
3. Include at least 3 individuals who are active voting members of CUUPS Continental and members of a UUA member congregation or the Church of the Larger Fellowship.
4. Provide a contact person for publication, who shall at all times be both an active member of CUUPS and a member of a UU congregation or CLF.
5. Submit an annual registration form and chapter fee of \$30. (The chapter fee is waived for chapters whose members include five or more current, dues-paying CUUPS, Inc. members. The renewal form is still required.)
6. A Statement of Mission and/or Purpose, and Bylaws/Operating Procedures for your Chapter. (Bylaws or other organizational documents can be sent in at the first renewal.)
7. A Covenant between your chapter and congregation and congregational leadership. The covenant can (and preferably will) include your congregation as a party to the covenant.
